For more than four decades, *Joshua Weinstein, M. Ed., M.B.A.*, has been an educator and administrator in both the public and private school systems. In 2004, Weinstein founded the **International Center for Autism Research & Education, Inc. (Icare4autism)**. He established the founding principles of *Icare4autism* after CABAS© (Comprehensive Application of Behavior Analysis to Schooling) method by Dr. Douglas Greer at Columbia's *Teacher's College*.

Icare4autism has also recently begun the *International Computer Analysis Program (ICAP)*, a worldwide database that will collate all ongoing and current research in the field of autism care and causes. Among our premiere objectives is that **Icare4autism's** extensive data bank will collect information from all segments of autism research and classify it into prospective categories. ICAP will enable researchers, worldwide, to access information in all areas including genetics, education, biologic factors, treatment, etc. This tool can be used by: researchers as a reference guide, therapists interested in implementing new techniques, and parents or others affected by this disorder.

Icare4autism has several programs for individuals researching the disorder. The **Icare4autism** research program calls for studying improved methods of diagnosis, early detection, and prevention by using approaches such as environmental neurobiology, genetics, and psychopharmacology.
